Cecile Saavedra is the Asia-Pacific region head for Standard & Poor's Credit Market Services (excluding Japan and Korea). Cecile joined Standard & Poor's in 1978 as a corporate rating analyst. In 1980, she transferred to the International Finance department to form the analytical group responsible for non-U.S. industrial company ratings. She established the Tokyo office in 1986 and had been based there prior to rejoining the New York office in June 1992. In 1996, she relocated back to the Asian region and established the Singapore office. Cecile manages the regional operations through the three branch offices – Hong Kong, Melbourne and Singapore. She is also actively involved in the oversight of affiliates, working closely with CRISIL in India, PEFINDO in Indonesia and PhilRatings in the Philippines. She is a member of the board of directors at Taiwan Ratings Corporation, a 50% joint venture.
