Douglas Arner is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law of the University of Hong Kong, where he specializes in financial markets regulation and development. He is the Director of the LLM (Corporate and Financial Law) programme and a Deputy Director of the Asian Institute of International Financial Law. In addition, he is a consultant with the Banking and Financial Sector Restructuring Department of the World Bank and Director of Research of the London Institute of International Banking, Finance and Development Law.

Prior to joining HKU in 2000, he was with London University's Centre for Commercial Law Studies and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development.

Douglas is co-editor of *Financial Regulation: A Guide to Structural Reform; International Financial Sector Reform: Standard Setting and Infrastructure Development*; and *Financial Crises in the 1990s: A Global Perspective*; and the author of numerous articles and chapters on international financial law. He has spoken in and co-organized conferences and seminars in Africa, Asia, Europe and North America and has worked with teams involved in financial sector reform projects in east Asia, Africa and central and eastern Europe and the former Soviet Union.
