

## James R. Barth

James R. Barth is the Lowder Eminent Scholar in Finance at Auburn University and a Senior Fellow at the Milken Institute. His research focuses on financial institutions and capital markets, both domestic and global, with special emphasis on regulatory and supervisory issues. Dr. Barth recently was the team leader for an Asian Development Bank project to advise the People's Bank of China on reforming the banking sector in China. He was the chief economist of the Office of Thrift Supervision until November 1989 and had previously served as the chief economist of the Federal Home Loan Bank Board.

He has authored more than 100 articles in professional journals and has written and edited several books, including *The Great Savings and Loan Debacle* (American Enterprise Institute) and *The Reform of Federal Deposit Insurance: Disciplining the Government and Protecting Taxpayers* (Harper-Collins). Dr. Barth received his Ph.D. in economics from Ohio State University.
