John Huai-zhong Li, Managing Partner of Simon Murray & Co. (China) Limited, has more than 10 years investment and industry experience in the U.S. and China. Held industrial positions at Nestle and Salk Institute and investment management positions at Deutsche Morgan Grenfell, Deutsche Bank Securities, Vega Fund and Southern China Fund Management. Acquired a lot of experience in Mortgage Backed Securities, Convertible bonds, and Fixed Income Management.

From August 2001 to July 2003, Mr. Li joined Southern China Fund Management (SCFM) as Director of Fund Management and Head of Fixed Income Investing.
