Dr. Qiao Liu is an Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Business and Economics of the University of Hong Kong, where he specializes in corporate finance, contract theory and Chinese economy. He is also an adjunct professor at the Center for China Economic Research (CCER) of the Peking University and a research fellow of the Institute for Social Science Research (ISSR) at UCLA. Qiao has published several academic articles at the leading finance and economics journals such as *Journal of Corporate Finance* and *Economic Inquiry*. He is also a regular contributor to the China's leading economic and financial newspaper *the 21st Century Business Herald*.

Qiao obtained his PhD degree in Finance and Economics from UCLA at 2000. After a short stint at HKU, he joined McKinsey & Company as Practice Manager in December 2001, where he led McKinsey's research in Asia-Pacific Corporate Finance and Strategy and advised various MNCs and leading Asian companies on issues such as M&As, IPO readiness, JVs, corporate governance, investor based finance, and etc. He returned to HKU in July 2003.
