

## Susie Cheung

Ms. Cheung joined The Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation Limited, which is wholly-owned by the Hong Kong SAR Government through the Exchange Fund, as its General Counsel and Company Secretary when it began operations in 1997.

Ms. Cheung obtained her LL.B. and LL.M. at University College in London. She is a qualified solicitor of the Supreme Court of England and Wales and of Hong Kong. She worked as a solicitor with major London City law firms specialising in banking and project financing before returning to Hong Kong in 1993. Ms. Cheung was also a Visiting Lecturer to the Centre for Banking and International Finance at City University in London for 3 years during her practice in London. She spent a year at the Tokyo office of a London City law firm in the late 1980's specialising in structured financing transactions. Ms. Cheung was also involved in advising specialist mortgage corporations in some of the early mortgage-backed securitisation transactions in London in 1980's and early 1990's.

Ms. Cheung is a member of the Working Group on Debt Market Reform convened by the Financial Services and the Treasury Bureau since January 2002 to pursue initiatives on the development of the debt market in Hong Kong.
