As Director of East Asian Legal Studies at Harvard Law School from 1964-79, Professor Cohen pioneered the introduction of East Asian legal systems and perspectives into American legal curricula. He is also a world renowned international lawyer specializing in Chinese law and China’s foreign relations. Recently, Professor Cohen has been active in a range of criminal and business disputes arising in mainland China and Taiwan as counsel and arbitrator.
