The Japanese business law community has recently experienced fundamental changes including the biggest amendment to the Civil Code and Company Law since their first enactment in the 19th century, and is expecting further amendment by 2009. In addition, Japan is in the midst of a revolution of its legal system including introduction of the jury system and US style legal education. Ms. Sese, with law degrees from the Universities of Tokyo, Harvard, Oxford and Hong Kong, 14 years experience as an in-house lawyer at Japanese banks, and now teaching business law at a newly established Japanese law school, will give an introductory lecture on these and other current issues in Japanese law.
