Tax in the Virtual World

The presentation suggests that there is no single suitable approach to this new phenomenon and the tax consequences are inconveniently dependent on the contractual relationship between participants and the provider of the virtual world environment.

He is an experienced practitioner and tax academic with a keen research interest in the taxation of intangible property.
