This 60-minute presentation aims to provide an overview on China and Hong Kong's Cross-Border Investment in the United States. This seminar will cover the different stages from filing with the Chinese authorities, financing alternatives, and due diligence to exit strategies. Due to time limitation, only one or two areas will be discussed. Audience will have the opportunity to learn more about the other stages in a cross-border transaction including public versus private acquisition, and private equity funding and investment. During the interactive Q&A session, audience is welcome to ask questions and get an insight from a renowned corporate lawyer.
